Download this application packet and fill out the form below. All application materials must be e-mail marked by **March 17, 2017**. Late applications and materials will not be considered. Any hand written application will be disqualified. All application materials must be sent by e-mail to: scholarships@thehaef.org. The result of your application will be sent to you via e-mail by May 30, 2017.

Scholarship Selection Criteria and Eligibility

- Any person of Hmong descent pursuing an education to better himself or herself and others.
- A U.S. citizen or legal resident alien.
- A Minnesota resident.
- A **high school senior** or has earned a **high school diploma** or **GED** and has been accepted fulltime to a public or private accredited 4-year college/university for the fall 2017 – 2018 academic year.
- Has a minimum GPA of 3.0 in a 4.0 scale system.
- Recipient is expected to attend Scholarship Awards Banquet on August 5, 2017.

Scholarship Application Packet, Checklist

- A completed application.
- Essay (1500 words or less).
- Copy of unofficial transcript (if selected you will need to provide official transcript.)
- Two letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation can be sent via E-mail to scholarships@thehaef.org

A Successful applicant must demonstrate the following

- A commitment to excellent academic achievement.
- A commitment to helping your community.
- This is a merit scholarship. Need base not necessary.

Essay: In one essay, 1500 words or less, please answer the following questions

- Tell us about your educational accomplishments.
- Tell us some of the things you have done to help your community.
- Tell us your needs and how this scholarship can help you.

Successful applicants are required to attend two general academic coaching, and mentoring sessions with
